DISPARITIES IN HEALTHCARE

MATT WILLIS, MD MPH MARIN COUNTY PUBLIC HEALTH OFFICER

OPERATING ON THE PRINCIPLE THAT THE HIGHEST ATTAINABLE STANDARD OF HEALTH IS A HUMAN RIGHT

DR. MATT WILLIS HAS PLACED HEALTH EQUITY AT THE CENTER OF MARIN COUNTY'S PUBLIC HEALTH PRACTICE. HE CALLS ON HIS EXPERIENCE AS A PHYSICIAN, AN EPIDEMIOLOGIST, AND A MEMBER OF THIS COMMUNITY TO ELEVATE HEALTH FOR ALL IN MARIN.

A MARIN NATIVE, DR. MATT WILLIS HAS BEEN THE COUNTY'S PUBLIC HEALTH OFFICER SINCE 2013. PRIOR TO HIS CURRENT ROLE, HE SERVED AS DIRECTOR OF PRIMARY CARE ON THE NAVAJO RESERVATION IN ARIZONA, AND IN THE U.S. CENTERS FOR DISEASE CONTROL IN ATLANTA, WHERE HE CONDUCTED OUTBREAK INVESTIGATIONS IN THE U.S. AND ABROAD. HE HAS PUBLISHED RESEARCH IN VACCINE EQUITY, CRISIS DECISION MAKING, TUBERCULOSIS CONTROL, DISASTER RESPONSE, AND OVERDOSE PREVENTION. HE LIVES IN SAN ANSELMO WITH HIS WIFE AND THREE CHILDREN.

THE ART OF MEDICINE IS TAKING CARE OF PEOPLE AND TRULY LISTENING TO THEM." LIZ, AS SHE'S KNOWN IN MARIN CITY WHERE SHE GREW UP AND STILL LIVES, SPECIALIZES IN KIDNEY DISEASE IN CHILDREN. SHE RECEIVED HER MEDICAL DEGREE FROM UNIVERSITY OF KANSAS SCHOOL OF MEDICINE AND HAS BEEN IN PRACTICE FOR MORE THAN 20 YEARS. "WHAT I REALLY LOVE MOST ABOUT MY JOB IS WORKING WITH PATIENTS AND THEIR FAMILIES. EVEN THOUGH THERE ARE MANY TIMES WHERE I CAN'T CHANGE THE SITUATION OR TAKE THE DISEASE AWAY, I WANT FAMILIES TO KNOW THAT I'LL ALWAYS BE THERE TO WALK THEM THROUGH TOUGH SITUATIONS AND TO SUPPORT THEM."
